The mission of the EWC is to save lives by preventing and reducing the devastating effects of cancer for Californians through education, early detection, diagnosis and treatment, and integrated preventive services, with special emphasis on the underserved. EWC is part of the Department of Health Care Service's Cancer Detection and Treatment Branch (CDTB).

Breast Cancer Screening Information

Do you qualify for **free** services? You may if you:

- are 40 years old or older
- have low income ([EWC Income Criteria](#))
- have medical insurance that does not cover breast cancer screening
- have a high insurance deductible or co-payment
- are not getting these services through Medi-Cal or another government-sponsored program
- live in California

Cervical Cancer Prevention Information

Do you qualify for **free** services? You may if you:

- are 25 years old or older
- have low income ([EWC Income Criteria](#))
- have medical insurance that does not cover cervical cancer prevention screening
- have a high insurance deductible or co-payment
- are not getting these services through Medi-Cal or another government-sponsored program
- live in California
