POSITION SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Director of Behavioral Health Services, the clinical supervisor provides individual as well as group supervision to pre-doctoral and post-degree, pre-license candidates, MFT Interns and Associate Social Workers. Additionally, the clinical supervisor is responsible for coordinating the intern training program which includes an intensive one-week orientation training and on-going weekly group supervision and training.

The Center's **Behavioral Health Services** provide services to the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender (LGBT) and HIV/AIDS communities. General services include crisis counseling, information, and referral; individual, couple and family counseling; psychosocial assessment, triage and treatment planning; and an intern and professional training program for the provision of LGBT and HIV/AIDS mental health services.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Successful completion of terminal graduate training program in a psychotherapy-related field: Ph.D./Psy.D., M.A., or M.S. in psychology; M.S.W.; M.F.T., etc., at an accredited university or college. **A valid California psychotherapy license, which has been maintained for a minimum of 3 years, is required.** Professional experience providing psychotherapeutic service to individuals/families with HIV and LGBT individuals or families is required.
2. Must be familiar with Windows environment. Basic word processing skills, including working knowledge of MS Word, are required.
3. Strong organizational skills and strong writing skills are required.
4. **Fluency in Spanish is preferred; fluency in spoken and written English is required.**
